## Dear all,

The CNZ Tournament Committee has decided to share the feedback received after each CNZ event and to comment on what changes, if any, they plan to make to events for the following seasons. ## Response to feedback

- 1. "I felt that management should have posted the results on croquet scores instead of leaving it to a player to update"
  - Action: From 2018, CNZ now meets with Managers before events and explains what is expected from them.
- "I was very disappointed with only 4 entries in the doubles although the round robin was ok. Pukekohe Level 3+ worked very well, a real shame no trophy or badge available."
  Action: CNZ to investigate providing suitable prize for the 3+
- 3. "I was not expecting to be playing at Pukekohe as the venues advertised in the Year book were Howick & Manurewa-there was no mention of games being played at any other venue. I had to travel 40 minutes to get there. To have the event split between Howick and Pukekohe was inconvenient"

Action: CNZ to investigate why the correct venues were not listed in the Yearbook and ensure accurate Yearbook entries in future.

Overall, this event received very positive feedback which is quite remarkable given that multiple clubs were involved – congratulations to them. Low entry numbers to doubles events is an increasing problem. We may need to work more closely with Regional Associations to encourage doubles entries.
