Format - the following feedback was received

Number of games per day – the following feedback was received.

- I like untimed games but many of them ran over such that we were playing until dark most evenings and then pegging down.
- The length not the number was the issue
- 3 games per were excellent
- 3 games a day no time limit

Based on this feedback, and that of other invitation events, CNZ will review time limits for these events.

Lawns – the following feedback was received.

- I have never seen United so green
- best lawns in the country
- Should have been mown during event. Hoops were widened after first round on the opinion of one player

CNZ TC Response

As a tier 2 event, the aim is for lawns of 10+ seconds. Hoops are as per tournament regulations of largest ball + 1/16" with an upward or downward tolerance of 1/32". As long as widening of the hoops was within the allowable tolerance, this should be at the manager's discretion.

Unfortunately was little time for mowing the lawns during the event, as evidenced by the feedback about most evenings where play continued until dark.

Manager - the following feedback was received.

- The manager was also the groundsman and hoop setter. Tony worked from 7am to 8pm every day so deserves special recognition.
- The manager had a calm manner about him which kept the players on an even keel
- Did cope very well with all games pegged down
- Difficult job as play was slow with a large number of games pegged down. This put pressure on completion. Largely due to slow players.
