

Croquet New Zealand Tournaments At Red

24th March 2022

Overview:

As New Zealand appears to be reaching the peak of the Omicron outbreak, the Prime Minister announced the relaxation of restrictions under the Red Setting of the Covid Protection Framework which would come into effect from 11.59pm Friday 25th March 2022.

This document outlines the new guidelines for CNZ tournaments under the new Red Settings, and are effective from 11.59pm Friday 25th March 2022.

Croquet New Zealand Tournament Requirements:

- My Vaccine Passes are required for all participants, workers / volunteers, and spectators. These must be shown to tournament management upon arrival.
- There is no limit to people outside. However, use of the clubrooms should be limited to only when required.
- Face masks are not required outside. Face masks must be worn while in the clubrooms unless seated eating and/or drinking. If you are unable to maintain physical distance from others, we encourage wearing a face mask.
- Physical distancing should be maintained at all times when reasonably possible.
- If individuals are feeling unwell, they should stay home.
- If a participant contracts Covid-19, they should immediately contact the Tournament Manager. They will be removed from the draw and those in attendance will be advised to monitor for symptoms. If possible, the tournament may continue.
