## WCF ENTRY FEE POLICY

| Purpose:        | To outline the financial support Croquet New Zealand will provide for New Zealand players who have gained a ranking, membership, host or qualification place at a WCF event.   |

| Policy:         | <p>All CNZ WCF World Championship individual event entrants, not classed as Youth U21, will be required to pay \$125 event fee. This fee will be used to cover part of the WCF event entry fee and a NZ shirt.</p> <p>The CNZ CE will have the discretion to waive this fee in cases of financial hardship.</p> <p>This fee must be paid two weeks before the start of the event. If a player is awarded and accepts a late or qualification place entry (within two weeks of the commencement of the event), payment of the fee is due immediately. CNZ will cover the remaining WCF entry fee cost.</p> <p>Any player that reaches the main knockout or the final of any plate event can make a claim for reimbursement of their \$125 fee. A claim for reimbursement should be filed with the CNZ CE no later than 8 weeks after the conclusion of the event.</p> |
