

CROQUET NEW ZEALAND WCF ENTRY FEE POLICY

Purpose:	To outline the financial support Croquet New Zealand will provide for
	New Zealand players who have gained a ranking, membership, host or
	qualification place at a WCF event.

Effective Date:	1 September 2018 (revised subsequently)
Policy:	All CNZ WCF World Championship individual event entrants, not classed as Youth U21, will be required to pay \$220 event fee.
	This fee will be used to cover part of the WCF event entry fee and a NZ shirt.
	The CNZ CE will have the discretion to waive this fee in cases of financial hardship.
	This fee must be paid be paid two weeks before the start of the event. If a player is awarded and accepts a late or qualification place entry (within two weeks of the commencement of the event), payment of the fee is due immediately. CNZ will cover the remaining WCF entry fee cost.
	Any player that reaches the main knockout or the final of any plate event can make a claim for reimbursement of their \$220 fee. A claim for reimbursement should be filed with the CNZ CE no later than 8 weeks after the conclusion of the event.
	In case of player withdrawal the above event fee is refundable as follows:
	i. if the withdrawal occurs prior to the event cut-off date: 90%ii. after the cut-off date: 50%.
